INSTRUCTIONS:

Who may apply for an absentee ballot?

Each person must apply for themselves. It is a felony to make a false statement in an application for an absentee ballot, to attempt to cast an illegal ballot, or to help anyone to cast an illegal ballot.

Where and when to return your application:

Applications sent by mail must be received at least seven days before the election, or hand-delivered to the Village Clerk up until the day before the election to 235 Lincoln Place, Westbury, New York 11590. If you have not received your absentee ballot by the day before Election Day, please contact the Village Clerk at 516-334-1700.

Options available to you if you have an illness or disability:

If you check the box indicating your illness or disability is permanent, once your application is approved you will automatically receive a ballot for each election in which you are eligible to vote, without having to apply again. You may sign the absentee ballot application yourself, or you may make your mark and have your mark witnessed in the spaces provided on the bottom of the application. Please note that a power of attorney or printed name stamp is not allowed for any voting purpose.

When your ballot will be sent:

Your absentee ballot materials will be mailed to you at least 6 days before the election in which you are eligible to vote. If applicant or agent delivers the application to the Village Clerk in person after the seventh day before the village election and not later than the day before the election, the Village Clerk shall deliver such absentee ballots to applicants, or their agents named in the application, when such applicants or agents appear in the Village Clerk's Office.
